Artwork should promote a better understanding of Missouri, its regions, communities and people, both past and present. This art show has been endorsed by the *Missouri 2021 Committee*. City Centre Dances return on September 17, with a "Fall Ball". Act Two Community Theatre will return in November with the comedy *Blythe Spirit*.

**Golf Focus Committee:** John Shetterly reported that staff is doing a great job and the course looks wonderful. The fence adjacent to Hole 16 was replaced and the neighbors are very happy. The next PRAB Meeting will be held at the Golf Course and will include a tour.

**Historical Focus Committee:** Alderman Townsend shared that the Historical Focus Committee has been getting a lot of calls from the community regarding the project of identifying over 1,000 historic photographs of places and people in St. Peters. Not only has the community volunteered to help with this project, but retired employees have been helping as well.

**Sustainability Focus Committee:** Alderman Sartorius stated the City has been speaking with Ameren about the possibility of converting some City vehicles to electric, adding electric vehicle charging stations in St. Peters, and the possibility of adding solar panels.

**NEXT MEETING**


