Guests of the RV park also can enjoy a 4.5-mile pedestrian/bike trail around the lake, sprayground, and **St. Peters resident rates for fishing, boating and archery** (must get a daily pass at RV Check-In, see fees below).

FISHING/LAKE USAGE FEES

Catch and release on bass, bluegill and catfish. Lake is closed Dec-Feb for boating and fishing.

FREE for St. Peters residents with Resident Privilege Card and 370 Lakeside campers; \$2 per pass (fishing OR lake usage) for general public.

PRIMITIVE GROUP CAMPING for Groups Only: DAILY \$30

*Weekly & monthly fees must be paid in full to receive discount. 60-day maximum stay at weekly or daily rates. Stays in non-wheeled sleeping units have additional restrictions.

Rotomill (gravel) is 15' wide with a minimum of 15' of grass area next to the rotomill. Pull-through site is $35' \times 71'$ minimum total width, and back-in site is $35' \times 61'$ minimum total width. All sites have 20, 30 and 50 amp service.

RV CAMPGROUND AMENITIES

- Level gravel sites, free Wi-Fi, paved roads, picnic tables on concrete pads & fire ring.
- Clean comfort station with restrooms, showers and laundry.
- Pets welcome! Must be leashed.
- Convenience store at RV check-in station.
- Patrolled by community service officers and park rangers 24/7.
- Access to nearby sand volleyball, play area, horseshoe pits and the Old Tyme Picnic Pavilion.

ARCHERY RANGE PASSES

Open year-round, sunrise to sunset. Also available for stargazing.

\$3 for St. Peters resident adults and 370 Lakeside campers; \$5 for general public.

Youth passes (ages 15 & under, must be accompanied with paying adult) are \$1 for St. Peters residents/370 Lakeside campers or \$3 for general public.
